HOW TO ADD OR REMOVE A FENDER SEAT NUT

for most Harley Davidson® motorcycles

Many Harley-Davidson motorcycles mount their seat with a single screw at the rear of the seat, which goes into a nut mounted on the fender. This Fender Seat Nut sometimes needs to be moved up or down the fender, from a Solo seat position to a Two-up seat position, or vice versa (see Fig. A).

Fender Seat Nut Locator key Retaining clip

To Remove a Fender Seat Nut (see Fig. B)

- 1. Get a long zip tie (or a piece of wire tied into a knot at one end), push it up from under the fender, and through the middle of the seat nut;
- 2. While holding the zip tie from above the fender, remove the retaining clip from the seat nut.
- 3. Lower and remove the zip tie and seat nut from under the fender.

Install a Fender Seat Nut

Reverse the procedure, pulling the ziptie and seat nut up from under the fender, through the hole in the fender. When the nut's locator key is positioned correctly, reattach the retaining clip.
