


CIRO FILLER PANEL LIGHTS

Parts Included:

- Right Side Light Assembly
- l Left Side Light Assembly
- Hardware Kit Including:
 - 12 1/4" Flat washers
 - 4 1/4-20 x 3/4" **Bolts**
 - 4 1/4-20 Locknuts
 - 1 Dielectric grease packet
 - 1 Run/Turn/Brake Splitter Harness
 - 6 6" Cable ties

Installation Instructions:

-). Park on a level surface and shub off the bike. Ensure that the engine has had time to cool before installation.
- 2. Remove your saddlebags by turning the two fasteners inside counter-clockwise. Lay your bags on a soft surface, out of the way.
- 3. Identify which Giro Filler Panel Light goes to which side by looking at the back.
- 4. Insert the wire from the light through the large chrome oval opening.
- 5. Place the light housing in the large opening with the tabs on the inside surface. Align the holes of the light housing with those of the oval.
- 6. Insert a 1/4-20 x 3/4" bolt and washer through the aligned holes from the outside. Fasten on the other side with a washer and 1/4-20 locknut. Repeat this for both holes on each side. Do not over-tighten



- 7. Roube the wire up along the top of the outer edge of the fender and secure it with cable ties as shown in the previous image. When you get to the air line, follow it to get the wire into the space under the seat.
- 8. Locate the black lighting connector at the rear of the under-seat area. Disconnect this and plug the Ciro Run/Turn/Brake splitter harness in-line with it.



- 9. Plug the wires coming from the rear filler lights into the wires coming from the splitter harness. The brown should be on the right, and the violet on the left.
- 10. Turn the bike on to accessory power and verify that all lighting is functioning as expected.
- 11. Re-install your saddlebags and observe the angle at which the lights are sitting. If clearance is an issue anywhere, use the included extra washers to shim the lights at their mounting point.
