


Read all instructions carefully and completely before installing your new POWRFLO™ Intake.

1. Remove the (4) bolts that hold on right side air cleaner cover. Remove chrome cover and filter from air box.
2. Remove the air box by loosening the (4) screws around the air inlet. Remove those screws from the cylindrical tabs on the air box. Then remove the (1) M6 hex bolt from the lower portion of the air box. See Figure 1. The air box needs to be pulled outward to remove it from the throttle body adapter.
3. On the backside of the throttle body adapter detach the two rubber hoses by squeezing the hose clamps with a pair of pliers and sliding them past the inlets on the throttle body adapter (plug the hoses if oil drips).
4. Using a phillips screw driver loosen the throttle body adapter hose clamp that secures the throttle body adapter to the throttle body. Remove the throttle body adapter leaving the clamp attached to it.
5. Using the (4) stock screws from Step 2 and supplied lock washers, bolt together the supplied velocity stack, mounting plate, throttle spacer to the throttle body adapter in the order shown in Figure 2. Note: Apply blue Loctite® removable strength (not supplied) to stock screws before bolting together.

6. Remove hose clamp from rubber seal on the backside of the throttle body adapter and flip 180 degrees then reinstall onto rubber seal, then rotate the clamp 90 degrees counter-clockwise so the screw is accessible from the lower frontside of the motorcycle. See Figure 2. NOTE: the locating tab on the clamp will no longer be engaged; this is correct.
7. Using (2) supplied $\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 x $\frac{1}{2}$ " buttonhead bolts, secure the fuel injector cover to the upper portion of the mounting plate, and tighten. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 x $\frac{5}{8}$ " hex flange bolt to attach the support bracket to the lower threaded hole and orientate as shown in Figure 3, but do not tighten.
8. The mounting plate assembly is ready to be attached to the motorcycle. Reattach the hoses and hose clamps that were disconnected in Step 3. Then engage the rubber seal of the throttle body adapter over the throttle body but leave the clamp loose for now.
9. Between the two cylinders is a bracket with a welded nut; align the slotted hole in the support bracket with that welded nut, then insert the (1) supplied M6 x 16mm buttonhead bolt.
10. Align and level the mounting plate assembly, then fully tighten the clamp over the throttle body adapter, then the bolt that secures the support bracket to the mounting plate, followed by the M6 bolt between the cylinders.
11. Place the supplied K&N® filter onto the velocity stack.
12. Remove the intake cover from the box and insert the intake screen into place so the holes in the bent tabs align with the threaded bosses in the intake cover.
13. Place intake cover over the mounting plate assembly and align the mounting holes to the threaded bosses. Insert the (3) supplied $\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 x $\frac{5}{8}$ " flange bolts and tighten the mounting plate to the intake cover. See Figure 4.




