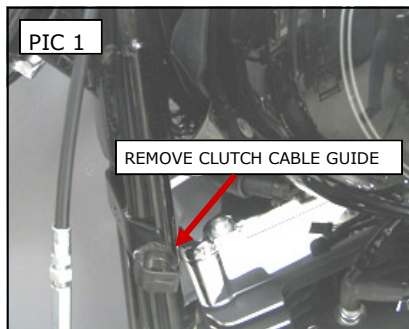

STEP 2 Remove the clutch cable guide fastened to the end of the cross bar. See PIC.1.

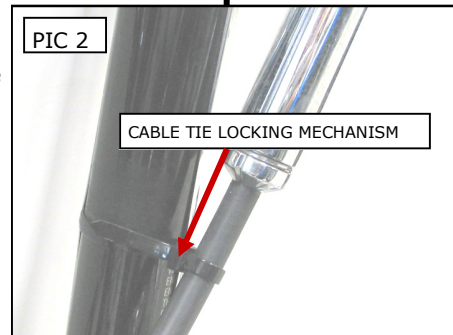

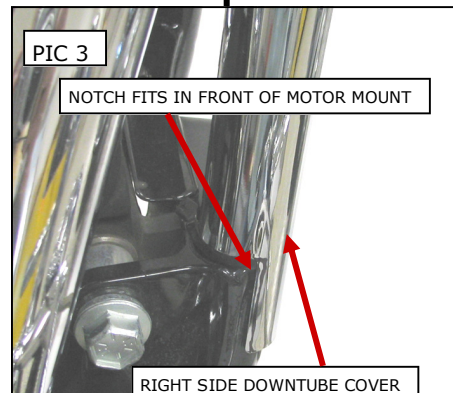
STEP 3

If the clutch cable is fastened to a downtube with tie wraps, be sure the locking mechanism on each tie wrap faces in, toward the center of the bike. PIC 2 The downtube covers will slide over the tie wrap straps. You may need to clip off the existing tie wraps and re-secure the clutch cable with new tie wraps, making sure the locking mechanisms face inward. **On ABS models** you will need to remove the clip on each side that holds the ABS line to the frame. Set these aside, they will be reused. Loosen the two Hex Head Cap Screws that hold the clamps together for the ABS module. PIC 6



STEP 4

Slide the downtube covers over the downtubes; the bottom of the downtubes have a cut-out to allow proper fit on the downtube. See PIC.3. Rotate the cover forward on the downtube so the cutout for the cross brace touches the weld on the frame for the cross brace. There is a right and left cover, be sure to use the correct cover. **On ABS models**, the covers will fit between the ABS module clamps and the frame.

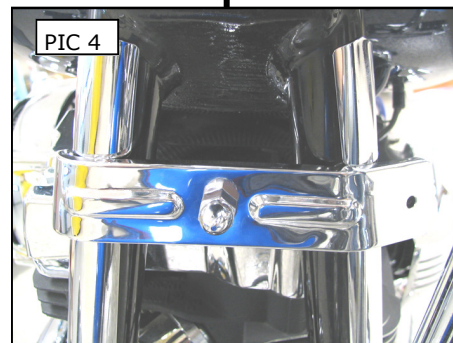


Note

If the cover seems to fit loosely, gently squeeze the downtube cover along its entire length for a better fit.

STEP 5

Install the cross bar cover and secure with the provided fasteners. See PIC.4. If your motorcycle is equipped with an engine guard, you will need to loosen the engine guard to install the cross bar cover.



STEP 6

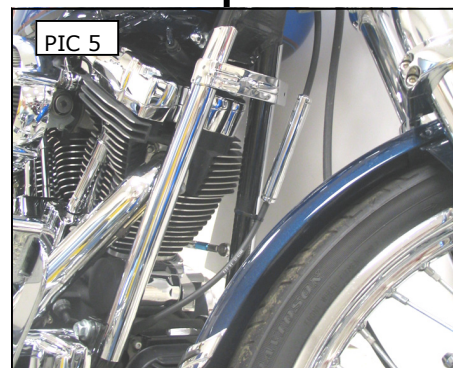
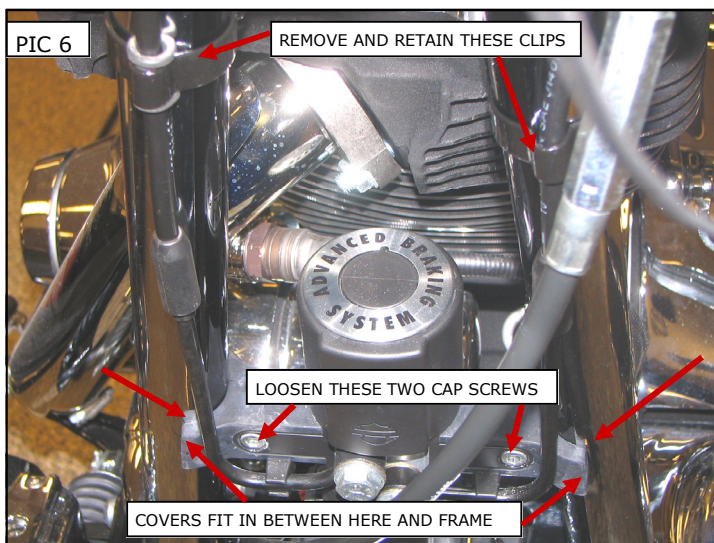
Reinstall the clutch cable guide. **On ABS models**, replace the brake line clips that were removed in Step 3. Tighten the Socket Head Cap Screws from Step 3.

CAUTION!

Ensure that the installation of this product does not interfere with the proper operation of the motorcycle before riding.

It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not warranty components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
