

PROCEDURE

1. Remove stock air cleaner assembly, breather lines, and throttle body support bracket NOTE: The throttle body support bracket will not be used with the Assault air cleaner.



NOTE: After removing the air cleaner assembly, clean and dry the throat of the throttle body, making sure it is free of any residue.

The new air cleaner is assembled in the packaging. Disassemble and prep the new air cleaner for installation.



NOTE: The velocity stack is secured by magnets—two on the stack and two on the backing plate. Do NOT coat the velocity stack; the magnets are irremovable. Use caution when removing magnets from the backing plate to avoid damage. Damaged magnets cannot be reused. Any coating process exceeding 200°F will cause magnet failure.

3. Prepare and fasten the sub-plate onto the throttle body. Apply red Loctite to the three provided 1/4 - 20 bolts that will fasten the sub-plate to the throttle body.



4. Align the sub-plate to the throttle body and heads, as well as the breather fitting on the back of the sub-plate.



5. Apply red Loctite to the provided 3/8 fasteners that hold the sub-plate to the heads and torque to spec.





6. Install the air cleaner backing plate using three 1/4 - 20 fasteners.





7. Install the velocity stack into the backing plate aligning magnets (it should snap into place).



8. Install air cleaner element onto the backing plate.



NOTE: Clock the air cleaner element so that the seam is on the bottom side.

9. Place the clear cover into the air filter.



NOTE: Clock the clear cover so the logo is straight.

10. Orientate the outer ring so the 3 tabs on the backing plate align with the 3 slots in the outer ring.



11. Install the 3 arms starting by hooking the pin behind the backing plate and rotating the arm into the slot on the outer ring.



12. Torque the stainless cap screws to spec, securing the bezel to the air cleaner.





13. Wipe your clear air cleaner cover clean, removing any fingerprints or smudges.
